Discipline Policy

1. Policy for Zones

In the event that a Zone is found to be

- a) In violation of policies, rules and bylaws of the THJA
- b) Publishing incorrect/contradictory/restricted information
- c) Engaging in activities deemed detrimental to the integrity of the THJA

Disciplinary action will include

- Formal written notice and required actions for resolution
- If resolution is not met, a Special Meeting of the THJA Board will be called
- If resolution is still not met, the THJA Board may appoint a hearing committee

2. Policy for Members (Zone Reps)

In the event that a Member (Zone Rep) is found to be

- In an undeclared Conflict of Interest
- In violation of the policies, rules and bylaws of the THJA
- Engaging in activities deemed detrimental to the integrity of the THJA

Disciplinary action will include

- Formal written notice and required actions for resolution
- If resolution is not met, a Special Meeting of the THJA Board will be called
- If resolution is still not met, the THJA Board may appoint a hearing committee

3. Policy for Registrants

Any violation will initially be addressed at the Zone Board. Failing resolution at the Zone Board, the Zone Board may request assistance from the THJA.

In the event that a registrant is found to be

- In violation of the policies, rules and bylaws of the THJA
- Engaging in activities deemed detrimental to the integrity of the THJA

THJA disciplinary action will include

- Formal written notice and required actions for resolution
- If resolution is not met, a Special Meeting of the THJA Executive will be called
- If resolution is still not met, the THJA Board may appoint a hearing committee
